

# iLearn

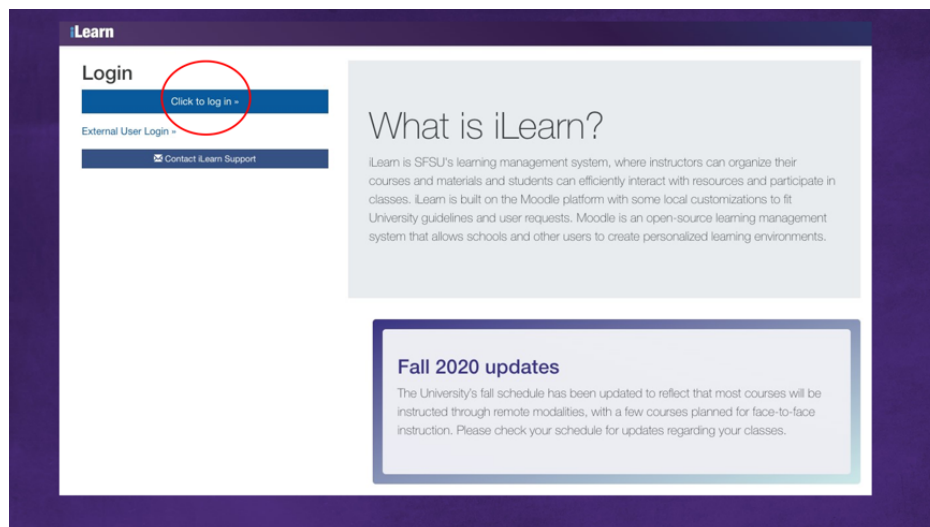
iLearn is SF State's learning management system, where instructors can organize their courses and materials and students can efficiently interact with resources and participate in classes.

## What will you do on iLearn?

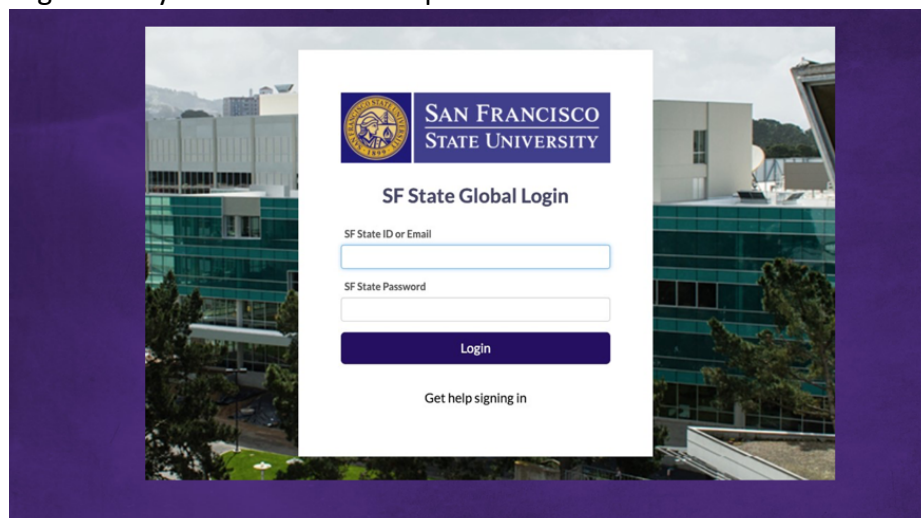
- Click Zoom link for your classes

## How to Access to iLearn:

1. Visit [ilearn.sfsu.edu](https://ilearn.sfsu.edu) and Click to log in



2. Log in with your SF State ID and password



3. Once the semester begins, you will find your classes under 'My Courses'

To access courses in iLearn, navigate to <https://ilearn.sfsu.edu> and click on the **Click to log in** button. You will be taken to the campus login page where you can log in using your SF State credentials like you do for campus email and other services. Classes are listed in the **My Courses** block on the left side of the page.
